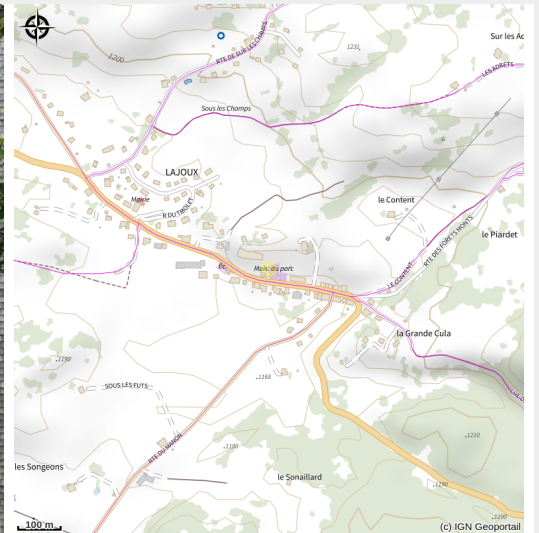

- A visit to a strong attic (“grenier fort”), a remarkable component of the High-Jura’s small rural heritage
